

Parish Hall adds fellowship space at church campus

Prior to **LUSK & Associates Inc.** getting involved with the Holy Family Catholic Church Parish Hall project, church leaders had been working on the design and pricing for the new facility and were growing frustrated. That is until LUSK got on the scene.

About the same time the Rev. Willie Hickey was transferred to Holy Family. He had worked with LUSK during construction of St. Brendan's church and insisted that LUSK pull in the superintendent from that project, Don Ehlers, to this Marietta job.

"He was excited about the opportunity to work with Don again and he made that request and we were

happy to accommodate," said Project Manager Brent Nitschke.

The team tore down a 3,000-square-foot social hall that was built in the 1970s and constructed a 12,000-square-foot, two-story parish hall.

"This building has brought a new lifeblood to that parish," Nitschke said. "We were able to come in and capitalize on a vision they wanted to achieve."

This project won first place in the Design/Build category in new construction for contractors with gross construction revenue of \$5 million to \$20 million by the Georgia branch of
